

THE PERFECT PLAYOFF PLAN 16

EQUALITY

As of June 26, 2013 the former BCS, now the College Football Playoff CFP, decided on the format of their new Championship Playoff that has no interest in nor makes any provision for Equality among the Conferences or for the Schools. Now this CFP is adding another layer of complexity and questionable subjectivity in the selection of its 4 teams by using a 13 member Committee in addition to its totally off the wall ranking using a [Strength Of Schedule](#) metric.

It's obvious that nobody thinks the #1 vs #2 BCS format gave us the only teams that could win it all. And until now nobody has come up with a serious analysis of, nor plan for the remedy for this unacceptable failure, except now the **Perfect Playoff Plan 16** has proposed it.

Reform must begin with a [S.A.F.E. Philosophy](#) and in particular the principle of Equality. Here is the list of errors and the corrections to achieve Equality for every Team and Conference.

***Error #1** - Outside Organizations that prevent establishing Equality among Schools and Conferences.*

***Correction** - Return control of Major College Football to the NCAA under the direction of its schools.*

***Error #2** - Conference executives and money considerations dictating Conference size and membership.*

***Correction** - Schools select Teams to make Conferences of Equal status, size and strength of programs.*

***Error #3** - Automatic bids for some conference champions but not other conference champions.*

***Correction** - Award an automatic bid to the champion of every one of these now equal conferences.*

***Error #4** - Conference Championship Games played between mismatched division champions.*

***Correction** - Eliminate Conference Divisions by enlarging each of them to a 9 member Conference.*

***Error #5** - Scheduling a meaningless FCS Patsy game and a 13th game as a conference championship.*

***Correction** - Limit the season to 11 games over 12 weeks and institute the [No Patsy Rule](#).*

***Error #6** - Excessive travel for non-conference games as well as non-regionally aligned conferences.*

***Correction** - Make Regional Conferences based on the Power 5 Conference Divisions plus the 25 teams with the most wins from the Group of Five to total 9 teams in each of the 10 Conferences.*

The solution is a new [Major College Football Division \(MCFD\)](#) limited to 90 schools in 10 single division Football Only Conferences of equal size, status and strength thus equally sharing the [Best, Next and Last](#) programs. The **MCFD** will be based on the Power 5 Divisions. Dropping the last [11 FCS teams](#) added to the FBS and the [29 cupcakes](#) from the former Group of Five.

This Reorganization makes possible a 16 team, 4 round single elimination Playoff immediately following the Regular Season that includes all 10 champions and the 6 second place teams with the most wins to determine an [Undisputed National Champion](#) on the field of play.
