

# THE PERFECT PLAYOFF PLAN

## NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYOFF SERIES

The Reformed, Restructured and Realigned [NCAA Major College Football Division \(MCFD\)](#) will have an 11 game (12 week) Regular Season ending the Saturday after Thanksgiving. Followed immediately by the 16 Team, 4 Round, **National Championship Playoff Series (NCPS)** with Round 1 Elimination Home Games on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of December (see [NCPS 2020 Chart](#)).

**ROUND 1** : Made up of the 16 Playoff Teams in 8 on-site Home Elimination Games played on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of December. The 8 home teams will be scheduled from among the 10 Conference Champions with their opponent chosen by random draw from the remaining teams. There will be no rematches allowed in Round 1 or 2, opponents will be redrawn immediately.

**ROUND 2** : Will match the 8 Round 1 winning teams in the 4 **Quarter-Final** games played on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of December to give those schools and their fans ample time to make arrangements to attend. Opponents will be selected by a random drawing. Rematches from the regular season will be discarded and redrawn immediately.

The 12 NCPS teams eliminated in Rounds 1 & 2 will be eligible for [Level I Post Season Bowls](#).

**ROUND 3** : **National Championship Playoff Semi-Final Bowl** games will be played on or before December 31<sup>st</sup> in the **Overton's Citrus Bowl**, Orlando, FL and the **Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl**, Atlanta, GA about 9 days before the National Championship Game.

**ROUND 4** : **National Championship Game** will be played by the winners of the Round 3 Bowls on or after January 7<sup>th</sup>. Hosted each year at the City with the winning bid.
