

MAJOR COLLEGE FOOTBALL DIVISION

POST SEASON BOWL COMPETITION

For the **Major College Football Division 90** the NCAA will license [27 Bowl Games](#) to be divided up with 7 Bowl Games in the final 3 Rounds of the **National Championship Playoff Series (NCPS)** and 20 Bowl Games for the **Post Season Bowl Competition (PSBC)** among the 10 Conferences of the new 90 team **Major College Football Division (MCFD)**.

The **PSBC** begins after the 3rd Saturday of December, ending by January 4th before the **National Championship Game** and will honor the teams with winning records during the Regular Season and determine the Football Conference of the Year on a point system for Bowl wins based on its 3 Levels. Each Conference is guaranteed 4 Bowl invitations based on eligibility.

Level I: Will consist of the **5 Major Bowls** listed below selecting from the Conference Champions not in the Semi-Final Playoff Bowls and Second Place teams to replace Conference Champions committed to the final 2 Rounds of the **National Championship Playoff Series (NCPS)**. The Conferences receive 3 points for each win.

Rose Bowl, Sugar Bowl, Orange Bowl, Fiesta Bowl & Cotton Bowl

These Bowls will be played on December 31st and January 1st and will have their traditional Conference ties based on team availability.

Level II: Will consist of the following **3 Bowls** selecting from the remaining Second Place teams based on their Conference ties and as nearly as possible their traditional dates.

Alamo Bowl, Outback Bowl & Holiday Bowl

These Bowls will be played on Dec 30th or 31st. Conferences receive 2 points for each win.

Level III: The final **12 Bowls** will select their Teams beginning the Sunday after the end of the Regular Season. Each Bowl will invite Third, Fourth or Fifth Place Teams with winning records available from their contracted Conferences in the order of priority listed in the [Selection Plan](#) approved by the **MCFD** membership. Conferences receive 1 point for each win.

**Academy Texas, Camping World, Music City, Belk, TaxSlayer Gator,
Las Vegas, Military, Birmingham, First Responder, Independence,
Quick Lane Detroit & Cheez-It Cactus Bowls.**

The remaining 16 Bowls approved by the NCAA Div I FBS for the 2020 Season will be dropped from the Major College Football Division's **Post Season Bowl Competition**.
