The 29 Cupcakes

The [Major College Football Division](#) is based on the [S.A.F.E. Philosophy](#) and the [No Cupcake Rule](#) which requires every Conference and Team have Fair treatment and an Equal status in the Division assuring that every School has an Equal chance to play for the National Championship and no team or Conference has Cupcake status.

The 2019 Regular Season of the NCAA Division 1 FBS featured 130 teams with unequal status in 10 Conferences of unequal status, size and strength of programs. The [Perfect Playoff Plan 16](#) corrects this problem by reorganizing the FBS into a new football only [Major College Football Division](#) with the 90 most successful teams in 10 Conferences of Equal Status, Size and Strength of Programs. This requires a consolidation of the FBS that drops the weakest 40 teams of the 130 team FBS from 2019. Dropping the [11 former FCS](#) teams added since 2012 because of the [No Patsy Rule](#) and the 29 former Cupcakes with the weakest records overall. The following 29 Teams have failed to be competitive against the Power 5 Teams winning only 13% of those games over the last 9 seasons. (winning a combined 70 of 554 games)

Below is a chart of the 29 Cupcakes from the former Group of Five Conferences for the 2019 Season with their Regular Season wins percentage over the last 8 years in the first box and the 22 years since the BCS in the second box.

Army was included in the MCFD 90 to allow the 3 Service Academies to be in the same Division and play each other for the [Commander-in-Chief's Trophy](#).

Liberty University made the final transition from the FCS to the FBS as an Independent making 11 Former FCS Patsy teams in 2019 and maintaining the Group of Five teams dropped from the MCFD Cupcakes to 29 teams after the 2018 move of the **Idaho Vandals** to the Big Sky Conference of the FCS.

(*) **UAB** dropped football after the 2014 season but restarted its football program for 2017 joining the CUSA West to keep the FBS at 130 teams.
