

Perfect Playoff Plan

The **Best 16 Teams** will play in a 4 Round Single Elimination **National Championship Playoff**. These 16 Playoff Teams will be taken from the new 90 team 10 Conference football only **Major College Football Division**. The 10 Conference Champions receive an Automatic Bid to the Playoff plus the 6 Second Place teams with the most wins.

Undisputed National Champion

This is the only Plan intended to determine an...
unchallenged, unquestioned, generally agreed upon and universally accepted National Champion
of Major College Football.

No Polls, No Computers and No Committees using secret votes. Just Wins decide the 16 teams!
The 10 Conference Champions from the new **Major College Football Division** and the 6 Second Place Teams with the most wins will make up the 16 Teams in the 4 Round Single Elimination Playoff to determine the National Champion.

10 Conferences based on the Power 5 Conference Divisions made up of the 65 Power 5 schools and 25 Group of Five teams with winning records the last 8 seasons.

National Championship Playoff Series

The 4 Round 16 Team Single Elimination Playoff begins with 8 Round 1 home games on the 1st Saturday in December at 8 Conference Champion's Home Stadiums based on a rotating schedule with 2 Champions and 6 Second Place Teams as the 8 away teams each season. The two Conferences selected as away teams each season will be an away team only once in every 5 years not repeating the same conference home opponents in that 5 years. The Round 2 Bowl Games played on the 3rd Saturday, Round 3 Bowl Games on December 31st if possible and the National Championship Game 9 days later on the Saturday or Monday after January 4th. The Teams in the National Championship Game will play 15 games including the 11 game Regular Season and the 4 Playoff Games. The 12 losing teams from Rounds 1 and 2 will be eligible for an invitation to one of the 8 Level I and II Bowls on the 4 days around New Years.

Post Season Bowl Competition

The Perfect Playoff Plan has 27 Post Season Bowl Games made up of the 7 Bowls in the final 3 Rounds of the National Championship Playoff and 20 Bowls that will include the 12 Playoff Teams eliminated in the First 2 Rounds of the National Championship Playoff and 28 Teams with winning records selected by each Bowl Organization based on its Contracted Conferences. The 5 Level I New Years Bowls will select from their Traditional Conference Champions and the 3 Level II Bowls are reserved for the remaining Second Place Teams. Then the final 12 Bowls will select from the 3rd to 5th place teams with 6 or more wins from their contracted Conferences.

*Military Bowl will have a **Military Academy** or **Texas A&M**, **Virginia Tech**, **Notre Dame** or an **EAST** team that qualify in 4th place.

No Patsy Rule & No Cupcake Rule

No Team in the new Major College Football Division will play a Patsy from the lower Divisions, padding their record to qualify for a Bowl.

No Team in this new Division will play a Cupcake from the former Group of Five Conferences padding their record to make the Playoff.

The new Power 5 teams will only play other Power 5 teams, now known as the new Major College Football Division.

This presents a problem, the 64 Power 5 Conference teams and Notre Dame are not enough teams to make this new Division representative of Major College Football that includes the Best Teams for a Playoff.

There is a solution, include the 25 Group of Five teams with winning records the previous 8 seasons to make up a football only 90 team Major College Football Division based on the Power 5 Conference Divisions to make 10 Conferences with 9 teams each which then play an 11 game Regular Season with 8 Conference games and 3 non-conference games with other Major College Football Division teams.

Problems with the NCAA FBS & CFP

The current 4 Team College Football Playoff excludes 12 teams that might have included that year's National Champion.

Too many Regular Season Games (12 or 13).

Too many Weeks in the Regular Season (15 or 16).

Too many Teams in the FBS (130).

Then scheduling a Patsy Game to pad a teams record to win 6 games for a Bowl bid.

Scheduling Cupcake Games nobody cares about, that don't prove a Team's strength but only to pad their winning record.

Lastly Conference Championship games that prevent the 1st Saturday in December from being included in a larger Playoff.

The Fix is... the Perfect Playoff Plan

The 90 Best FBS Teams in 10 Conferences of 9 teams, that are equal in status, size and total strength of programs.

An 11 game Regular Season versus Major College Football teams only, over 12 weeks ending the last Saturday of November.

The Best 16 teams in a 4 Round Playoff starting the 1st Saturday in December, through the Saturday after January 4th.
